Science

The first Science assessment will take place on Tuesday 30th September. M side will be period 2 and H side will be period 4.

The assessment will be made up of paper 1 content and will consist of 2 x Biology questions, 2 x Chemistry questions and 2 x Physics questions. This will be the same for combined science and triple science.

- Students will be assessed using Assessment Objectives One, Two and Three.
- In addition to this the whole of Component One will be marked (this includes Project 1, 2 and 3).

Assessment date: **Wednesday 24th September 2025 – 2 hours.**

- In the assessment, students will be required to complete a photoshoot plan and a subsequent photoshoot in the time.
- Some students may have time to work on the presentation of their best photos and then edit these digitally/manually.
- They will need to have planned exactly what they are going to do and the materials/tools/objects for photoshoot they need to complete it, before they arrive.
- They will be assessed using Assessment Objectives One, Two and Three.
- In addition to this the whole of Component One will be marked (this includes previous projects and their independent project).
